Wine Festival Gala Showcases Northwest Wines

November 15, 2014

The Tri-Cities Wine Festival is an annual event at the beautiful and spacious Three Rivers Convention Center in Kennewick, Wash. The Tri-Cities Wine Society is excited to invite you to participate in its festival's judged competition, and the gala public wine tasting Saturday, November 15, 6:30-9:30 p.m. The festival is the Northwest's oldest, annual, continuously judged competition. Besides Washington, wineries from Alaska, Idaho, Montana and Oregon are invited to participate. More than 1,000 people attended last year's gala.

Judging and Wine Entry

- Blind judging with world-class judges; the panel represents trade, education, media, restaurants, retail, etc.
- Judging will be a majority rules, consensual procedure.
- No minimum production requirements; no limit on number of entries.
- All wines entered will be judged and all wines judged will be poured at the Gala Wine Tasting.
- Best of Show, Best of Class/Varietal, Double Gold, Gold, Silver and Bronze awards.
- Awards presented at the Gala Wine Tasting.
- Judging results will be sent to local, regional and national media.

Booth Registration

- \$200 entry fee for up to 8 wines; more than 8 wines an additional \$100 for a 2nd table.
 The fee includes judging and exhibitor booth with 6' table. Payment can be by check or credit card.
- Multiple wineries, but only <u>up to 8 wines total</u>, allowed per booth. An additional \$100 fee for more than 8 wines entered. <u>A separate winery application is required for each winery</u>.

Silent Auction

- Wineries may donate to the Wine Festival silent auction with or without entering the judged competition.
- Festival proceeds benefit the Tri-Cities Wine Society's educational fund.
- The Wine Society is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization; donations are tax deductible.

Other Information

- Culinary showcase with complimentary food provided by local restaurants and caterers.
- Micro brew tasting.

2014 General Information

- Entrants donate one (1) case of wine entered for judging: three (3) bottles for judging completion, nine (9) for use at the Gala Wine Tasting.
- FOR JUDGING: ship only three (3) bottles of each wine for judaina.
- FOR GALA TASTING: bring the remaining nine (9) bottles of each entry to the public Gala Wine Tasting for pouring.
- NOTE: wineries <u>must attend</u> the Gala Wine Tasting and <u>bring the exact wines entered for judging</u> in order to pour their wine and receive any awards. Wineries not present for the Gala Wine Tasting or not bringing the exact wines entered for judging will be eliminated from the Gala Wine Tasting and award recognition.

Entry Requirements and Information

- Only one (1) winery per entry form. Wineries may share a booth but individual winery entry forms are required.
- Completed forms will be processed as <u>first-come</u>, <u>first served</u>. Space is limited.
- Wineries must be registered with the Alcohol and Tobacco Tax and Trade Bureau.
- Educational institutions must have enology or viticulture programs.
- Winery booth set up between noon and 5:30 p.m. the day of the Gala Wine Tasting; <u>set up must be</u> <u>completed by 5:30 p.m.</u>
- At 5:30 p.m. the night of the Gala Wine Tasting, entrants <u>must attend</u> Festival pouring orientation.
- Entrants must staff their booth during the Gala Wine Tasting, including set up and pouring orientation.

The Convention Center liquor policy requires a Washington State MAST (Mandatory Alcohol Serving Training) card for all individuals pouring for Washington State wineries.

- Decorations, tasting notes and other literature are encouraged.
- Festival officials will provide entrants donation disclosure information after the event.
- Entrants may remove unused wine after the Gala Wine Tasting; wine not removed is a donation to the Tri-Cities Wine Society.
- Festival co-chairmen have final interpretation of rules/requirements and wine classification.

Booth Amenities

Booth includes: pipe & draping, skirted 6' table, two
 (2) padded chairs, dump bucket, a container and ice for white wines, carafe of water, bread/palate

Completing the Entry Forms

- Forms are fill-able! Download the form from the website www.tricitieswinesociety.com. SAVE AS using your winery name as the new file name.
- If needed, copy entry form for additional entries or download additional copies of the "Wine Entry Form" from the website.
- For wine "Class Code" refer to category listing on the left column of this page.
- Completed <u>original entry forms</u> must be received no later than Oct. 1.
- <u>Do not mail original entry</u> form with wine shipment.
- Keep a copy for your records.

Wine Shipping

- Ship only the required three (3) bottles of each entry for judging. Multiple entries may be shipped in the same container.
- Entrants are responsible for delivery, either from a distributor, or regular shipping or delivery methods.
- All wines must be shipped **PREPAID**.
- Label each box with winery brand name as on the entry form.
- For shipments of more than one box, label "Box 1 of 4," "Box 2 of 4" as appropriate.

Wines must be delivered by October 23

Wine Testival

- All wines <u>must</u> have varietal percentages indicated on the entry form.
- A varietal wine must contain at least 75% of the variety, or be entered in a blended category.
- All entries <u>must</u> have residual sugar percentage on the entry form, even if the percentage is zero.
- **REMINDER:** Ship only the three (3) bottles of each entry for judging. Bring the nine (9) bottles of each entry to the Gala Wine Tasting for pouring.
